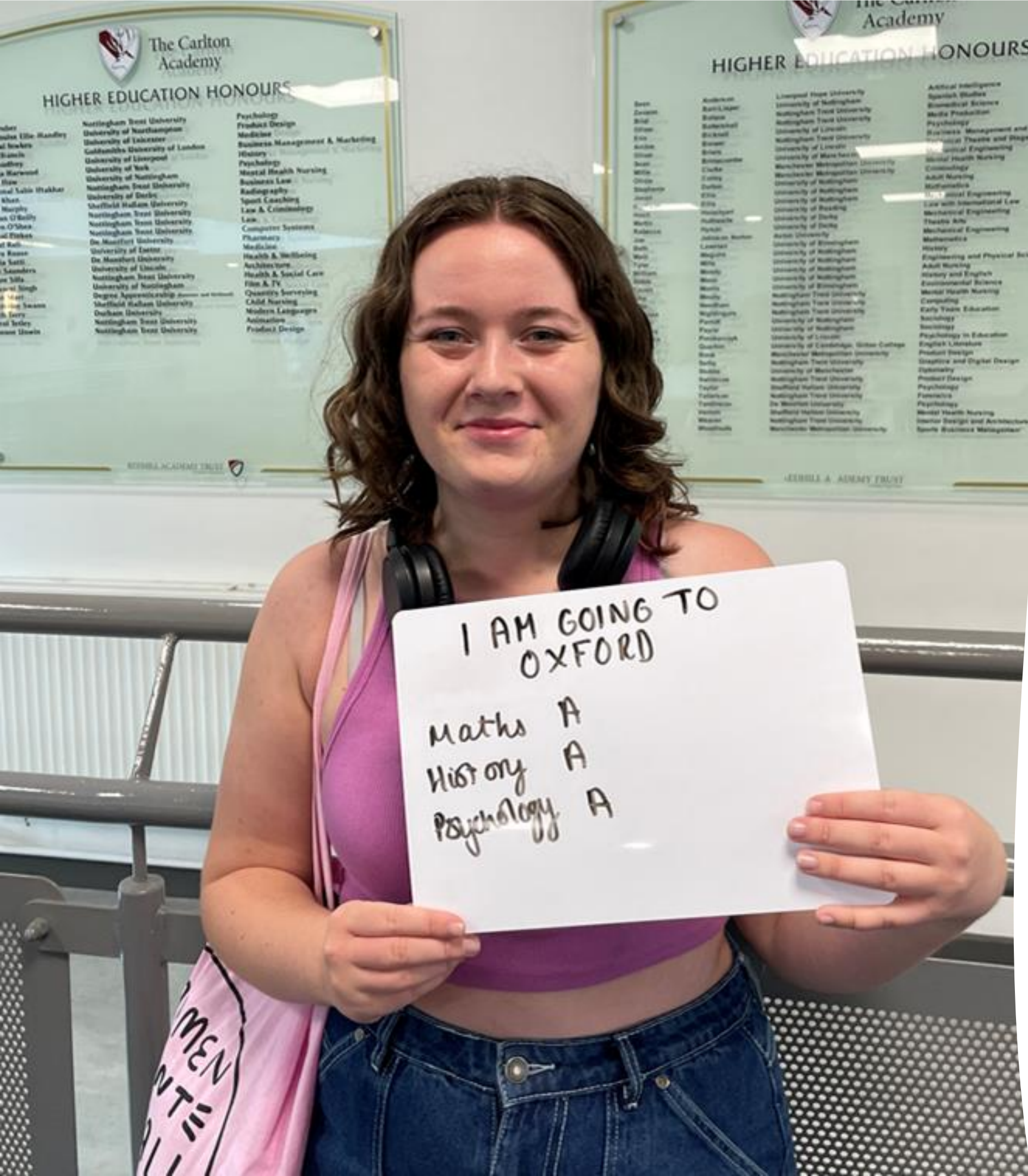

- 8% gained an apprenticeship – including Rolls Royce and RAF.



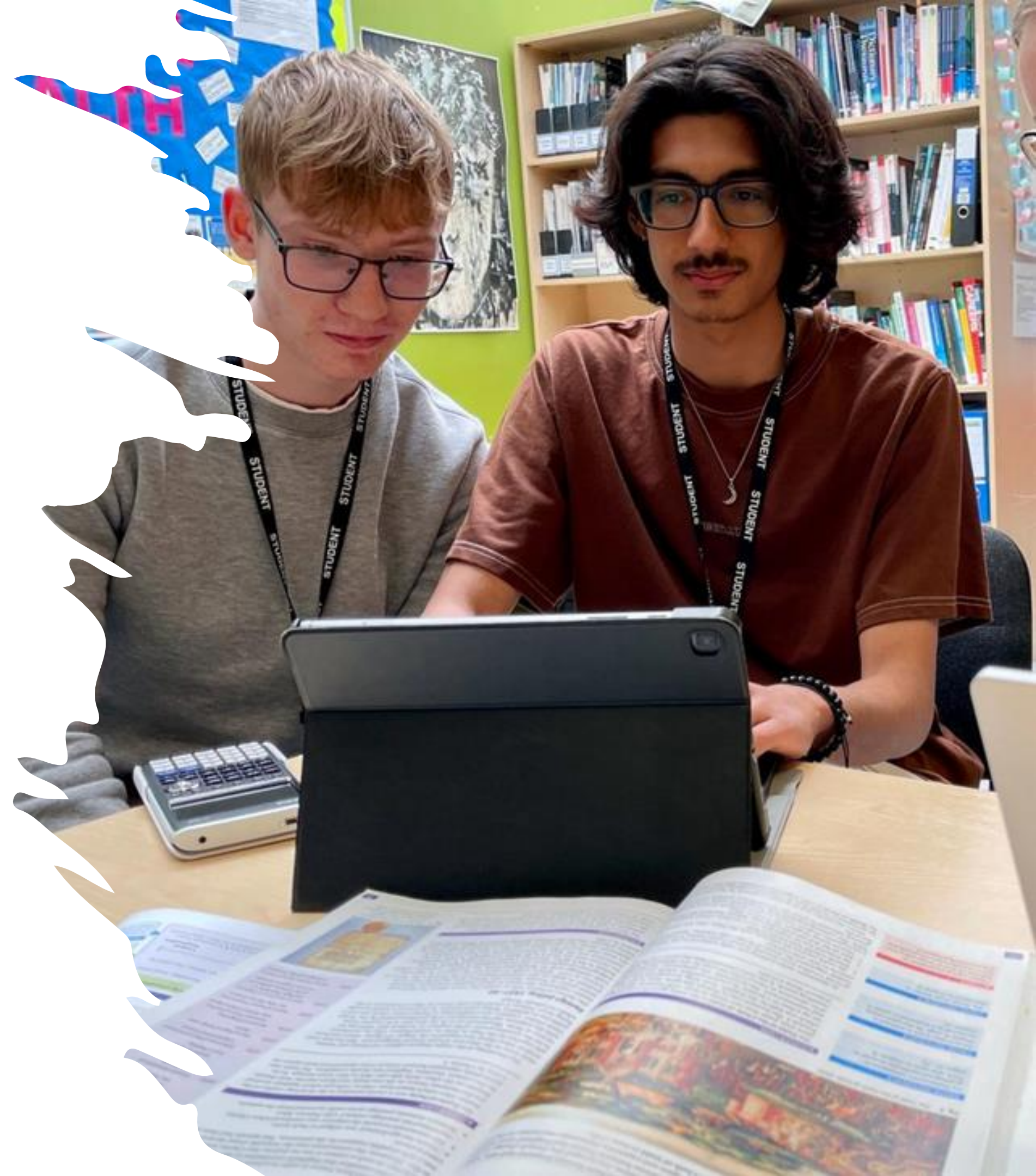
# How is Sixth Form different to college?

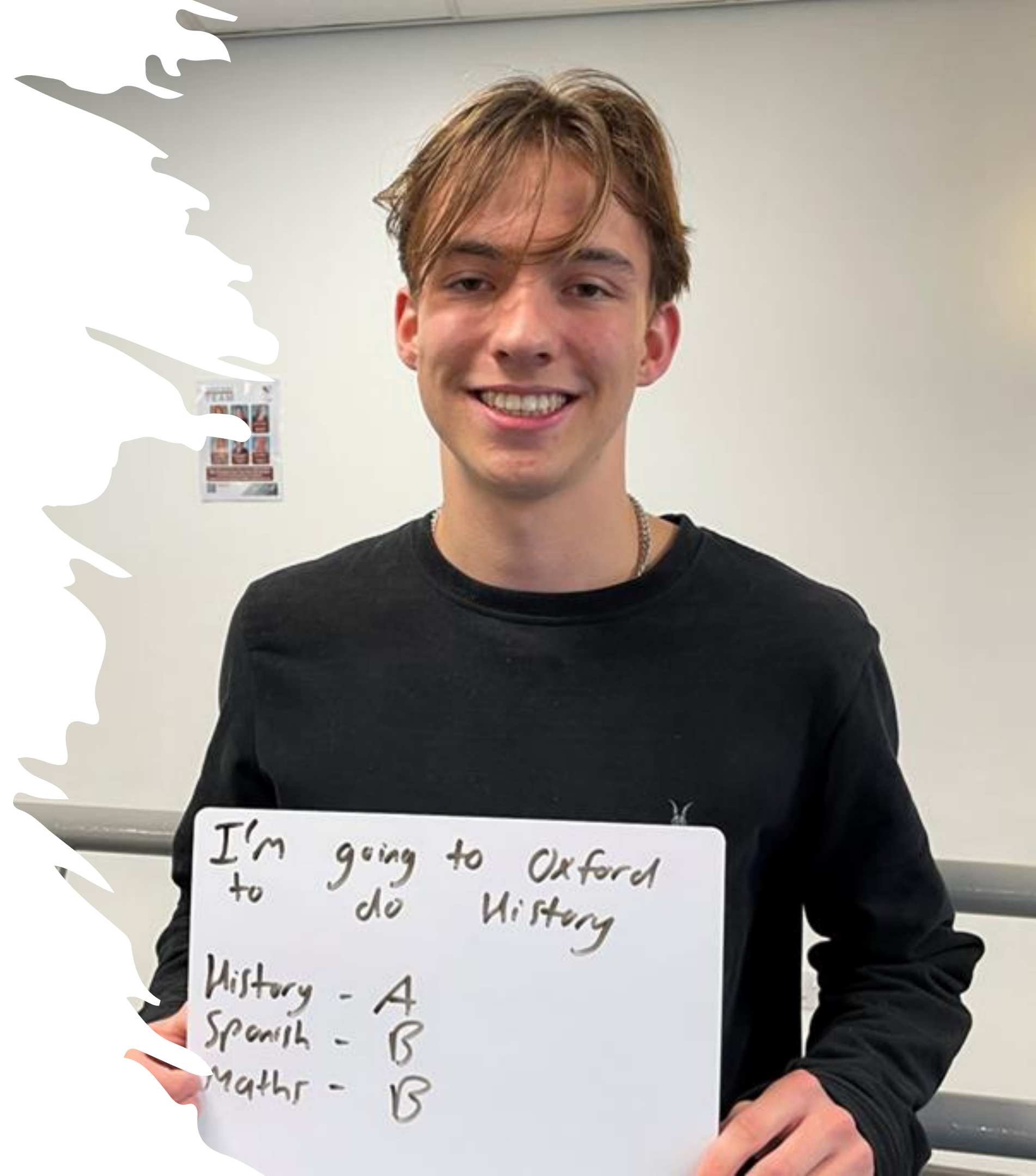

# Entry Requirements

- **General:**
  - At least five GCSEs at Grade 9-4, including English Language and/or Maths (preferably 5s in both)
- **Subject-specific:**
  - Grade 5s are required for A Level Maths and Science and a minimum of a grade 4 for other subjects


